The Sooners are committed to supporting the community that supports them.

Competing for the University of Oklahoma means being in the headlines, but it also gives Oklahoma student-athletes an opportunity to give back to Norman and the surrounding communities.

Head coach K.J. Kindler and the women's gymnastics squad have capitalized on this opportunity with the same enthusiasm OU fans display in rooting for their favorite team.

"It's a goal of our team to be very community oriented," said Kindler. "One of our primary missions as a coaching staff is to make sure the community knows that Oklahoma gymnastics wants to be involved."

In just the past year, the team has volunteered with Race for the Cure, the OU Children's Hospital, Habitat for Humanity, Adopt an Angel, the Ronald McDonald House, a Thanksgiving food and clothing drive, and created a banner for the U.S. Special Olympics gymnasts to carry with them in the opening ceremonies of the 2007 Special Olympics World Summer Games.
